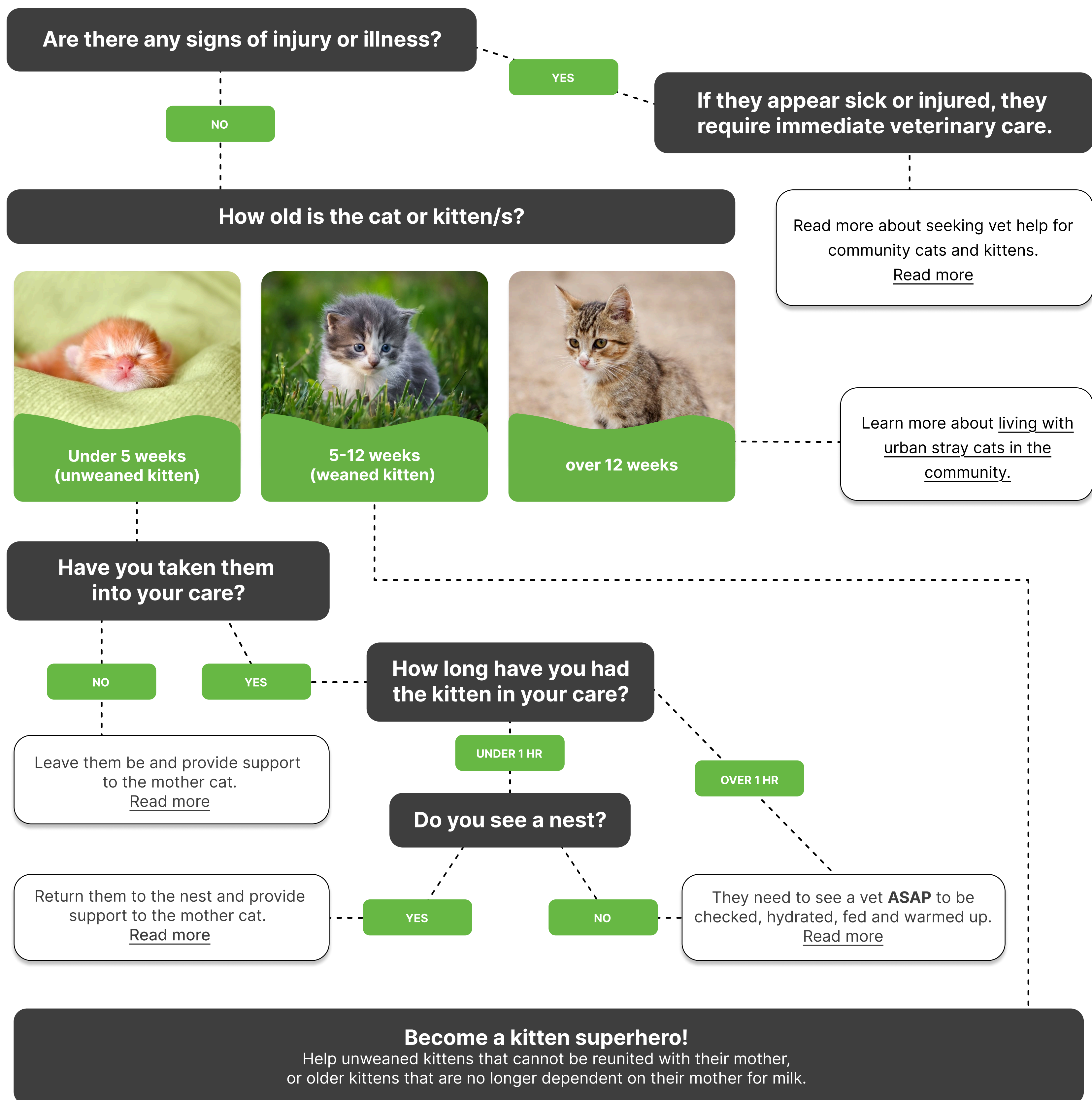




Help! I've found a stray cat/kittens!

Step 1. Take the kitten/s to a local vet.

Find out how old the kittens are, what care they need, vaccinations, microchipping and desexing. Some vet clinics operate re-homing centres or work with rescue organisations and may be able to take the kittens.

Step 2. Finding experienced rescue help.

Whether you're looking for guidance as you learn to care for a new foster litter, or need help with kittens you're unable to keep, reaching out to local rescue groups experienced with neonatal and unweaned kittens can be invaluable.
